GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES August 12, 2019

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 12, 2019, at 7:30 pm. in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Mayor Blazer, Recorder Trembush, Council Members: English, Anderson, Richmond and Zinn. Also present were Chief of Police Vogler, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers, Attorney Barney and City Clerk Rickman. Council Member Cunningham was absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Zinn and a second by English. Vote: Unanimous

Mayor Blazer recognized Kaden Minch of BSA TROOP #82 and Scout Master Tom Cook. Kaden addressed Council and explained that he is working to be an "EAGLE SCOUT" and would like to replace the flag poles and do some landscaping at the Glen Dale Park as his community project to help complete his requirements to achieve his goal. Mayor Blazer told him that Council would consider his request at the appropriate time later in the meeting while assuring him that positive consideration would be given.

Mayor Blazer also recognized Shane VanScyoc and Connie Williams who were in the audience. They informed Council that Pastor Jumper has retired and that they will be in charge of the Soap Box Derby in the future. They thanked the City for their past cooperation and look forward to future events. They also indicated that they are in need of a place to store the cars.

Tom Cook was also congratulated by the Mayor and Council on his new position as the new administrator of the Marshall County Health Department.

Zinn made a motion, second by Anderson, to accept the financial report as presented by City Clerk Rickman with bills in the amount of \$11,045.27 to be paid. Vote: Unanimous

Attorney Barney gave the second reading to "Enact an Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance of the Sewer Revenue Bond." Zinn made a motion, second by Richmond, to pass the bond on second reading. Roll Call Vote: English-abstain; Anderson-yes; Richmond-yes; Zinn-yes. Motion passed: 3-0-1

English made a motion to accept all standing committee reports and Zinn seconded. Vote: Unanimous

Richmond made a motion, second by Zinn, to approve the request of Kaden Minch to complete his project at the City Park as presented earlier with the assistance/guidance of the City. Vote: Unanimous

Anderson made a motion, second by English, to adjourn at 8:00pm. Vote: Unanimous
