

*GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES*  
*August 24, 2020*

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 24, 2020, at 7:30 pm. in the Glen Dale Fireman's Hall. Those in attendance were Mayor Blazer, Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Cunningham, English, Anderson, Richmond and Zinn. Also present were Chief of Police Vogler, Water Superintendent Orlofske and City Clerk Rickman. Street Commissioner Byers and Attorney Barney were absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Zinn and a second by English. Vote: Unanimous

Mayor Blazer recognized Explorer Scout Kaden Minch who was present to inquire about procedures to follow in raising flags on the new poles at the City Park in completion of his project to becoming an "Eagle Scout." The Mayor thanked him for his work and informed him to make the necessary arrangements and inform he and Council as to the time and date.

Francie Myers was also present to inquire about the Whipkey property on Wheeling Ave. Mayor Blazer informed her about the steps the City has taken concerning the property. He also informed her that the City could not and would not give her permission to go on private property and do anything on her own.


Anderson made a motion, second by Cunningham, to accept the financial report as presented by City Clerk Rickman with no bills to be paid. Vote: Unanimous

Cunningham made a motion, second by Zinn, to remove discussion/approval of raises for 2020/2021 Fiscal Year from the agenda. Vote: Unanimous


