GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES January 13, 2020

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 13, 2020, at 7:30 pm. in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Mayor Blazer, Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Cunningham, English, Anderson, Richmond and Zinn. Also present were Chief of Police Vogler, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers, Attorney Barney and City Clerk Rickman.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Zinn and a second by English. Vote: Unanimous

Mayor Blazer recognized Dr. Heather Taylor who was present to inquire about her future dental office and what procedure she needed to follow. Water Superintendent Orlofske informed her that Cerrone was performing a "perc test" on the soil pertaining to drainage. Also, Mayor Blazer informed her that the "Planning Commission" would meet to make a recommendation to Council for the meeting on February 10, 2020.

Mayor Blazer recognized a group of residents in the audience and gave each time to address Council.
