

GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
July 8, 2019

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 8, 2019 at 7:30 pm in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Anderson, Cunningham, English, Richmond, Zinn. Also present was City Clerk Rickman. Police Chief Vogler, Attorney Barney, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers and Mayor Blazer were absent.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting; English seconded. Motion carried.

Councilman Cunningham made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$8,760.02 noting that the Glen Dale Water bill would have to be adjusted to remove the Sewage charge for the swimming pool; English seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on deplorable properties including 620 Glen Haven and 28 Wheeling Avenue. Councilman Richmond suggested that Attorney Barney proceed with condemnation.

Councilman Richmond made a motion to accept the committee reports as presented; Zinn seconded. Motion carried.


Discussion was held on the construction signs that have been left throughout town. They are to be removed as soon as the project is complete. Also, a meeting will be requested with WV DOH in regard to the curbs and drainage.

Councilman Cunningham reported that the Baseball/Softball Association has received permission from St. Jude to install water lines at the Associations expense.


Larry English made a motion to go into Executive Session for personnel; Anderderson seconded. Motion carried.
