GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES March 08. 2021

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 08, 2021, at 7:30 pm. in the Glen Dale Fireman's Hall. Those in attendance were Mayor Blazer, Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Cunningham, English, Anderson, Richmond and Zinn. Also present were Chief of Police Vogler, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers and City Clerk Criswell. Attorney Barney was absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Zinn and a second by English. Vote: Unanimous

Mayor Blazer recognized Shane VanScyoc who was present representing the Soap Box Derby. He informed Council that the Derby would take place on June 5, 2021 and gave a brief update. He also was concerned about getting the cars out of our building on a Saturday. Street Commissioner Byers volunteered to make those arrangements.

Also in attendance were Greg Gellner and two of his neighbors with concerns of their Grand View Terrace Road. They were inquiring if the City would take over the road or at least help with the cost of the repairs to the pavement because of the heavy equipment that had used it during the work on drainage lines that were replaced. Mayor Blazer did not make any immediate decisions as to what could be done but that he would let them know.

City Clerk Criswell presented Council with a proposed budget for 2021/2022. After a brief discussion, Cunningham made a motion, second by Anderson, to table the Budget Proposal until the next meeting. Vote: Unanimous

Anderson made a motion, second by Zinn, to accept the financial report as presented by City Clerk Criswell with no bills to be paid. Vote: Unanimous

Zinn made a motion, second by Cunningham to table any action to Amend Ordinance 709.34 concerning Misc. Licenses to include Food Truck Vendors due to the absence of Attorney Barney. Vote: Unanimous

English made a motion to accept all standing committee reports and Zinn seconded. Vote: Unanimous

Anderson made a motion, second by Cunningham, to adjourn at 8:09pm. Vote:
