

# GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

March 9, 2020

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 9, 2020 at 7:30 pm in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Anderson, Cunningham, English, Richmond, Zinn. Also present was City Clerk Criswell, Police Chief Vogler, Attorney Barney, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers. Mayor Blazer was absent.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting; English seconded. Motion carried.

Cade Minch updated City Council on his plans for the new flag poles and landscaping at the Memorial at the Glen Dale Park. Cade is doing this for his Eagle Scout Project.

Dave Thomas, 615 Washington Ave, voiced his concern in regard to Taylor Dentistry. Mr. Thomas was advised that Dr. Taylor had the application in her possession to complete all the necessary information. No building permit has been issued at this point. Mr. Thomas also mentioned that he had problems with a building permit of his own that was turned in approximately 20 years ago.

Councilman Anderson made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$16,964.63; Eric Cunningham seconded. Motion carried.

Councilman Richmond updated Council on the events at the Cockayne Farmstead. He will get in touch with Mrs. Chaddock in regard to contacting the neighbors and obtaining event insurance for the upcoming Re-enactment event.

Councilman English recognized Caden Minch for his dedication to his Flag Pole Project at the City Park.

Lou Richmond made a motion to accept the committee reports as presented; Zinn seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson made a motion to adjourn; Cunningham seconded. Motion carried.
