

**GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES**  
**May 24, 2021**

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 24, 2021 at 7:30 pm. Those in attendance were Mayor Blazer, Council Members: Anderson, English, Richmond, Zinn, Cunningham. Also present were Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers, City Clerk Criswell and Police Chief Vogler. Attorney Barney and Recorder Trembush were absent.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting; English seconded.

Doug Loy came before City Council to address the potholes in front of his home.

Frank Borsuk addressed City Council in regard to the alley near the compressor station. Supt. Byers advised that the alley was not abandoned.

Eric Cunningham made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$5,247.60; Larry English seconded. Motion carried.

Superintendent Orlofske advised City Council that the backhoe is in poor condition and needs to be replaced.

Eric Anderson made a motion to accept the committee reports; Zinn seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the EPA requesting to do more drilling. Superintendent Orlofske will provide information as he receives it.

Councilman Anderson opened the discussion about who is responsible for 7<sup>th</sup> Street repairs. He also addressed the pontoon boat that is parked on Lee Street.

Councilman Richmond asked if the City could provide a pole for Hoagy Carmichael to hang a sign. He also inquired on the status of cleanup of Jamie Whipkey's property.

Discussion was held about obtaining "Sammy", a statue hand created by Former Mayor Jon Saffell.

A motion to adjourn was made by Eric Anderson and seconded by Eric Cunningham. Motion carried.
