GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES November 12, 2019

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, November 12, 2019 at 7:30 pm in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Anderson, Cunningham, English, Richmond, Zinn. Also present was City Clerk Rickman, Police Chief Vogler, Attorney Barney, Street Commissioner Byers, Water Superintendent Orlofske. Mayor Blazer was absent.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to approve the minutes of the 9/23/19 meeting; English seconded. Motion carried.

Eric Cunningham made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$5,471.23; Eric Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Lou Richmond made a motion to adopt a "Resolution Stating the Reasonable Expectation of the City Council of the City of Glen Dale, West Virginia to Reimburse the City for Capital Expenditures in Connection with the Planning, Design, Acquisition, Construction and Equipping of Certain Additions, Betterments and Improvements to the City's Sewer System Made Prior to the Issuance of Tax-Exempt Revenue Bonds"; Zinn seconded. Roll call vote: Cunningham, Anderson, Richmond, Zinn – Yea English – Abstain

Zoning Officer Elliott Grisell advised City Council that he will be turning over a request to put in a display lot for used vehicles to the Planning Commission. Mr. Grisell also presented the plans that Heather Taylor has submitted for relocation of her dental office. After discussion, this matter will also be presented to the Planning Commission after being reviewed by Superintendent Orlofske.

Larry English made a motion to accept the committee reports as presented; Richmond seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Eric Cunningham and seconded by John Zinn to donate \$100 to the Moundsville Veterans Honor Guard; motion carried.

Discussion was held on various properties throughout the town that need attention.

Councilman Eric Anderson discussed the condition of the curbs along Wheeling Avenue and suggested that we see if we can get some funding to help replace/repair them. He also discussed the need to begin a plan for a new Municipal Building.

Eric Anderson made a motion to adjourn; Eric Cunningham seconded. Motion carried.
