Richmond made a motion, second by Cunningham, to file a civil action complaint in the Circuit Court of Marshall County as discussed and presented by Attorney Barney with respect to the Jamie Whipkey property. ROLL CALL VOTE: Cunningham-YES; English-Yes; Anderson-YES; Richmond-YES; Zinn-YES Vote: Unanimous

English made a motion to accept all standing committee reports and Zinn seconded. Vote: Unanimous

Anderson made a motion, second by Cunningham, to adjourn at 8:35pm. Vote: Unanimous
