GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES September 23, 2019

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 23, 2019 at 7:30 pm in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Anderson, Cunningham, English, Zinn. Also present was City Clerk Rickman, Police Chief Vogler, Attorney Barney, Street Commissioner Byers. Councilman Richmond, Water Superintendent Orlofske, and Mayor Blazer were absent.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting; Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Recorder Trembush called Mr. Johnathan Clark to the floor for a hearing on his property at 620 Glen Haven Avenue. Mrs. Cortnie Clark was not in attendance. Mr. Clark brought updated pictures of the property to City Council showing the improvements that he and his father have already made. Attorney Barney reviewed the letter from the Marshall County Health Dept with Mr. Clark who agreed with all the recommendations within the letter. Mr. Clark was instructed to get a City Building Permit for all the work being done. Mr. Clark agreed to have the recommendations given by the Marshall County Health Dept completed within 2 months. It is Mr. Clark's intentions to sell the property once all the renovations are complete. Mr. Clark apologized to the entire City Administration for what has happened in the past. He specifically apologized to Councilman John Zinn since they were neighbors. Councilman Eric Cunningham made a motion to allow Mr. Clark 60 days to complete the necessary recommendations of the Marshall County Health Department; John Zinn seconded. Motion carried.

Councilman Zinn made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$6,322.42; English seconded. Motion carried.

Eric Cunningham made a motion to approve the 3rd and final reading to Enact An Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance of the Sewer Revenue Bond; Anderson seconded. Roll call; Cunningham – yes, English – abstain, Richmond – absent, Anderson – yes, Zinn – yes Motion carried.

Larry English made a motion to accept the committee reports as presented; Zinn seconded. Motion carried.

Attorney Barney is researching some information in regard to forced compliance for nuisance properties.

Anderson made a motion to adjourn; Cunningham seconded. Motion carried.
