## GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES September 27, 2021

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 27, 2021, at 7:30 pm. in the Glen Dale Fireman's Hall. Anderson made a motion, second by English, to accept the financial report as presented by City Clerk Criswell with bills in the amount of \$6,787.81 to be paid. Vote: Unanimous

Water Superintendent Orlofske presented Council with a bid for a new one ton water truck to replace the old one. Zinn made a motion, second by Anderson, to accept the bid of \$45,095.00 from Bob Robinson Chevy, Inc. Vote: Unanimous

English made a motion, second by Zinn, to buy "baited rat traps" to be placed on the Whipkey property and Mr. Whipkey is to reimburse the City for the cost. Vote: Unanimous

Richmond made a motion to accept all standing committee reports and English seconded. Vote: Unanimous

English made a motion, second by Zinn, to accept a letter of resignation for Officer Ezekiel Goddard as presented by Chief Vogler. Vote: Unanimous

Richmond made a motion, second by Zinn, to hire two additional part time police officers as requested by Chief Vogler. Vote: Unanimous

Anderson made a motion, second by English, to adjourn at 8:06pm. Vote: Unanimous
