

GLEN DALE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

January 09, 2023

Glen Dale City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 09, 2023, at 7:30 pm. in Council Chambers of the Glen Dale City Building. Those in attendance were Mayor Scott, Recorder Trembush, Council Members: Cunningham, English, Anderson and Zinn. Also present were Chief of Police Vogler, Water Superintendent Orlofske, Street Commissioner Byers, Attorney Potts, Accountant Abraham and City Clerk Yoho. Councilman Richmond and Interim Clerk Hunt were absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Zinn and a second by English. Vote: Unanimous

Accountant Abraham gave a detailed financial report of the different accounts of the City for the previous two months. Anderson made a motion, second by Cunningham, to accept the financial report as presented. Vote: Unanimous

Water Superintendent Orlofske requested Council to hire Timothy Beaver to fill a vacancy in the water department. Zinn made a motion, second by Anderson, to hire Timothy Beaver as requested. Vote: Unanimous

Cunningham made a motion, second by English, to pass on first reading an Amendment to Subsection 733.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Glen Dale pertaining to Business of Contracting as presented by Attorney Potts. Vote: Unanimous

Mayor Scott presented a Cable System Franchise Agreement Proposal for the City from Comcast Cable. After a brief discussion, Zinn made a motion with a second by Anderson to approve the proposal. Vote: Unanimous

English made a motion to accept all standing committee reports and Zinn seconded. Vote: Unanimous



Cunningham made a motion, second by Anderson, that the City purchase a "Card X Reader" to handle all credit card charges coming to the City as recommended by City Clerk Yoho. Vote Unanimous

Mayor Scott addressed a letter from Frank Borsuk that was presented to Council pertaining to the use of a public alley. She is going to try to rectify this situation.

Anderson made a motion, second by Cunningham, to adjourn at 8:45pm. Vote: Unanimous
